 - Differentiate signage violation in fine table
 - For which violations will the ARC issue a fine on first offense?
 - Advance recommended CP changes to EB for approval consideration.
 - Initiative to execute policy review by legal counsel.
 - Brainstorm objectives for this endeavor
 - Proposal to conduct a pilot effort by selecting two policies for review, as well as formulating questions to ask counselor
 - Identify candidate law firms.
